Moving towards the goal of 100% electrification–CORE

Taking forward the ambitious goal of 100% electrification of Broad Gauge Route by December 2023 set by Government of India, the Bengaluru Project Unit of Central Organization for Railway Electrification Prayagraj has commissioned the electrification works of **Arsikere-Birur (40RKM)** section of Mysuru Division on 29/11/22, **Chikkabanwara-Solur (33.5RKM)** and **Nitur-Sampige Road (11RKM)** of Bengaluru Division of South Western Railway on 30/11/22. Similary Secunderabad Project unit has commissioned **Pangri-Ausa Road (80RKM)** section of Solapur Division of Central Railway on 30/11/22.

Arsikere-Birur section is the part of Bengaluru Hubballi route and after completion of electrification of this patch now Electric Trains can ply seamlessly from Bellary to Arsikere via Chikjajur. This section is part of Bangalore - Hubballi line where Vande Bharat Exp is planned to be started in current financial year by Ministry of Railway. Bengaluru Unit of CORE is working tirelessly for expeditious completion of Electrification of balance patches of this route.

Pangri-Ausa Road RE work has been commissioned on 30/11/2022. This is a part of the Electrification work of Miraj-Kurduwadi-Latur Road section (377 Route Kilometers). Commissioning of Miraj-Kurduwadi-Pangri (243 RKM) was done on 31.03.2022. With the commissioning of Pangri-Ausa Road (80RKM) on 30/11/2022, 54 RKM Ausa Road-Latur section will be balance and completed by December 2022. After this the entire section of Miraj-Kuduwadi- Latur will be electrified and Goods and Express/Passenger trains can run seamlessly with Electric Traction upto Ausa Road.

Central Organization for Railway Electrification is playing an extremely important role in making Indian Railways a Green Railway with emphasis on reducing Carbon Emission and dependence on imported fuel thereby saving precious foreign exchange.

General Manager CORE, Shri Pramod Kumar congratulated all concerned on this major achievement and expressed happiness that CORE is continuously moving towards the goal of 100 percent electrification.
