**CORE achieves another milestone – Electrifies 3000 RKM of BG network.**

Indian Railways has embarked upon an ambitious plan of electrification of its complete Broad Gauge network which would not only result in a better fuel energy usage resulting in increased throughput and reduced fuel expenditure but also savings in precious foreign exchange. Indian Railway is progressing at full throttle towards **Mission 100percent electrification** with 86% RKM electrification achieved in an endeavour to become the world's largest Green Railways.

Taking forward the goal of 100% electrification, the Ahmedabad project unit of Central Organisation for Railway Electrification (CORE) commissioned the electrification works of Kapadvanj-Modasa (59.67/60.54 RKM/TKM) section under Vadodara division of Western Railway on 09/03/2023. With this CORE has commissioned 3000 RKM of BG network till date in the current financial year which is a significant jump of 21% compared to the corresponding period of last financial year. This is a major accomplishment for CORE under the able leadership of its General Manager, Shri Pramod Kumar and will give a big boost to clean and green rail transportation network.

Work on electrification of balance BG network, targeted in the current financial year is going on in full swing and all out efforts are being made to commission the sections in excess of 5000 RKM. A no. of important sections are due for commissioning in the balance period of current financial year and

therefore, close monitoring of important works are being undertaken at all levels in coordination with Zonal Railways & State Agencies.

General Manager, Shri Pramod Kumar congratulated all concerned on this major achievement and expressed happiness that CORE is playing a leading role in ***Mission 100percent electrification***. At the same time, he called upon team CORE to work tirelessly towards achieving the goal during the balance period of March's 23.
