CORE Celebrates Independence Day

The 73rd Independence Day was celebrated with joy in the office premises of the Central Organization For Railway Electrification, Allahabad Shri Alok Gupta-Chief Administrative Officer/CORE hoisted the national flag. A Colorfully turned out contingent of Railway Protection Force presented guard of honor. The Chief Administrative Officer congratulated all the officers and employees of the CORE.

Chief Administrative Officer Shri Alok Gupta read the Independence Day message of General Manager/CORE, Shri Rajiv Agrawal. He told that in the current year, the Railway Board has given a challenging target of electrification of 6234 Route kilometers to CORE. In the first four months of the current financial year, 346 Route kilometers of track have been electrified. It includes important links like Fatehabad-Laxmibai Nagar, Dhosvas-Javara, Kukaddam-Vishnupuram, Chandausi-Raja Ka Sahaspur and Bandikui-Mandavar. Apart from this, section of 453 route kilometers is prepare for CRS inspection.

He said that in order to achieve the new goal, improvement in working methods, transparency in procedures and new technology has been used. The traditional mode of tendering has been changed in to EPC tendering. Under the Digital India program of the Government of India, e-RTI, IMMS and e-TC has been implemented for Works tenders. This has led to improved efficiency of various processes and increased transparency.

He further stated that during the period of 15 August 2018 to 15 August 2019 many major achievements have been achieved in the Country and Railways like launching of Chandrayaan-2, Electrification of 3613 route kilometers by CORE and saving in electricity expenditure, operation of Vande Bharat Train , the formation of a new zone South Coast Railway, cleanliness at stations and increase the public amenities, etc. He told that the passion of railway employees to do progressively better work always enables us to succeed in achieving every goal.

Following the message of General Manager, a grand cultural program was organized under the direction of Railway Electrification Women Welfare Organization. On this occasion, Chief Administrative Officer Shri Alok Gupta announced awards to the departments for organizing function successfully. The national flag was also hoisted at Triveni Vihar Railway Colony Ram Bagh Allahabad and Railway electrification projects spread across India i.e. Ambala, Ahmedabad, Chennai, Danapur, Jaipur, Jodhpur, Lucknow, New Jalpaiguri, Bangalore and Secunderabad and the Independence Day message of General Manager, CORE was read.
